Preparation for childbirth at Goldenes Kreuz

Information evenings

A presentation by our midwives in German language will introduce you to the different areas of obstetric care at Goldenes Kreuz Private Hospital. If circumstances permit, you may also be able to visit a delivery room and a room in the maternity ward.

Charge: There is no charge for participation. There is no need to register in advance. Of course your partner is very welcome to come with you.

Minimizing pain in childbirth

Well before the birth our information sessions in German language include explanations and discussions on the various different types of local anesthesia available during childbirth. Max Gosch, MD, or a member of his specialist team for obstetric anesthesia and pain therapy will be happy to give you details of the options for minimizing pain in childbirth.

Consultation with a midwife, as part of the mother-child health passport program (18th to 22nd week of pregnancy)

In addition to medical screening by a doctor, the mother-child health passport program includes an advisory consultation with a midwife, between the 18th and 22nd week of pregnancy. This provides information about pregnancy, childbirth and the postnatal period, options for prenatal classes, exercise and nutrition during pregnancy, choosing where to have your baby, preparation for breastfeeding, and information about the first days with your baby.

The consultation takes about an hour, and the cost is reimbursed in full by your insurer. 

Traveling to the hospital

To complete the necessary admissions paperwork we will need

- Your personal details on the "Birth History" form
- · E-card or social security number
- Policy number of your Austrian supplementary health insurance, or supplementary insurance card
- Photo ID
- Signed admission agreement this includes a summary of

essential information that you will need for your admission and treatment at our hospital.

- A signed copy of our Data Protection Statement
- A deposit payment, if you are paying for your own treatment and not using supplementary insurance.

For your medical care we need you to bring the following with you, please

- Mother-child health passport
- · Written confirmation of your blood group
- · Where available, ultrasound and lab test results
- Allergy ID card
- Any medications you take regularly



Collecting umbilical cord blood to bank stem cells

If you are interested in having some umbilical cord blood collected in order to bank stem cells, please discuss this in good time with your attending doctor. You will need to complete the registration with the stem cell bank yourself.

Goldenes Kreuz Private Hospital has a collaborative arrangement with the stem cell bank VITA 34 – www.vita34.at – which is registered as a tissue bank with the Austrian Federal Office for Safety in Health Care (BASG - Bundesamt für Sicherheit im Gesundheitswesen). Goldenes Kreuz receives a quality report twice a year from the stem cell bank. Midwives and doctors are regularly trained in the collection, documentation and handling of this material.

Services offered by private supplementary insurance providers

Most Austrian supplementary insurance providers offer their clients very favorable terms to cover newborn babies, with contracts that are valid from childbirth onwards. For example, the first year of insurance may be offered free of charge, as a special "welcome bonus".

Supplementary insurance policies for newborn babies typically include cover for ultrasound examinations during pregnancy (prenatal diagnostics) and investigations such as an ultrasound hip check, kidney ultrasound, and a hearing test.

Your insurance adviser will be happy to provide specific information about the services offered by your insurer. We suggest that you arrange to discuss this at an early stage.

Ultrasound hip check for newborn babies

At Goldenes Kreuz Private Hospital we offer an ultrasound hip check, which is carried out in the neonatal ward itself during the first few days after delivery.

This allows any developmental issues to be reliably and promptly identified and treated.

You can also bring your baby to Goldenes Kreuz for his/her monitoring check between the 3rd and 8th week after birth.

Other ultrasound investigations

If other diagnostic investigations are needed, our experts can also carry out high-quality ultrasound examinations of the kidneys, sacral dimple or cranium in the neonatal ward. Cardiac ultrasound can also be performed in our Radiology Institute.

Neonatal hearing test

If you wish you can have the newborn hearing test carried out during your stay at Goldenes Kreuz.

Whv

Normal hearing is very important for your child's development. Before the introduction of the neonatal hearing test, half of all hearing problems were identified too late.

How

The inner ear itself produces "sounds" which can be detected by a microphone placed in the ear canal, similar to the way a smartphone earbud is used.

Since these sounds are very quiet, it is best to carry out this measurement while your child is asleep, or perhaps while he/she is feeding!



Our test is completely painless and generally takes just a few seconds. In a few rare cases, if hearing is not at the expected level, a further check may be necessary. The most common cause is a postnatal obstruction in the ear canal, such as amniotic fluid or earwax. In such cases the measurement is repeated later, and only if this also produces a "negative" result, then further investigations may be needed at a specialist center.

When/where

Tests are carried out on Monday, Wednesday and Friday mornings, in your room or in the neonatal ward.

Costs

For this examination (including a second test within a month if necessary) you will be invoiced by Goldenes Kreuz Private Hospital for the fee of €43.

Even if the hearing test is normal, it is important to monitor speech development in your child's second year. If any developmental delays are apparent, further investigation is recommended.





Breastfeeding

Breastfeeding is the ideal start to the relationship between mother and child. This intensive contact stimulates all the baby's senses. Breast milk also aids the child's development, contributes to the build-up of the immune system, protects the gastrointestinal system, and has been shown to reduce the risk of allergies.

In short: Breastfeeding is best thing you can do for your baby.

Help with breastfeeding

If you want to breastfeed your baby, our qualified pediatric nursing and healthcare professionals will be very happy to support you. They will be delighted to share their expertise with you in breastfeeding groups and individual counseling sessions. If you have any difficulties establishing breastfeeding, you can also consult our qualified breastfeeding and lactation consultant (IBCLC).

Breastfeeding advice after you leave the hospital

If you need help and support with breastfeeding problems after you leave the hospital, you are welcome to contact us and make an appointment for a personal consultation. For urgent questions we are also happy to help on the phone!

Nutritional advice for pregnancy and breastfeeding

From the 12th week of pregnancy onwards your energy requirements increase and remain high until you finish breastfeeding. So it is important to ensure you optimize your energy supply.

You need twice as much of some vitamins and minerals, from the start of pregnancy onwards. This also means it is advisable to eat high quality food with enough nutrients, vitamins and trace elements.

Taking your baby home

What your baby needs for the journey home

- outdoor clothing (bonnet and cardigan of a suitable thickness for the season)
- a onesie
- · a jacket/pullover
- · a romper suit
- · and a blanket

Of course, during your stay in hospital we can provide clothing for your baby.

Keep your baby safe right from the very first trip home

ÖAMTC (the Austrian Automobile Association) provides **baby seats** to Goldenes Kreuz which can be rented out to parents for the first year of the baby's life. These seats

have been tested for compliance with the strict requirements of the ECE R44/04 standard and specially checked by ÖAMTC: they are the first to be made specifically for newborn babies (0-13 kq).

Terms and conditions for rental of baby seats in group 0+

The rental fee for 12 months is €49. When you collect your baby seat, you will need to pay deposit of €199; you sign a completed rental contract at Goldenes Kreuz and you will then receive an invoice and payment slip from ÖAMTC.

When you return the baby seat in a clean condition, the deposit will be returned to you, less the rental fee. If the seat is damaged or dirty, you will be charged for repair or cleaning, up to a maximum amount equivalent to the purchase price. Seriously damaged or dirty seats – as determined by the ÖAMTC sales office – will not be accepted.

Outpatient rehabilitation exercise classes

We will help you to restore your fitness quickly after the birth of your baby. As part of your immediate postnatal care you can begin some exercises, with guidance from our physical therapists, which will make the first few weeks at home easier.

3 to 5 weeks after the birth of your baby you can begin a targeted, more intensive rehabilitation exercise program, which we provide as an outpatient service at Goldenes Kreuz. Even for mothers whose baby was delivered by cesarean section, rehabilitation exercises begin in the 3rd to 5th week after childbirth.

With guidance from our physical therapists, you will learn exercises to promote correct posture, to prevent incontinence and for general relaxation.


